<u>Journal of Data Science and Intelligent Systems</u> (JDSIS, eISSN: 2972-3841) is an international, peer-reviewed, interdisciplinary journal that provides in-depth coverage of the latest advances in the closely related fields of data science and intelligent systems.

JDSIS will provide publishing service for the contributing authors of *2025 International Symposium on the Application of Artificial Intelligence in Electrical Engineering* (**AAIEE 2025**). The service details are stated below:

- 1. **JDSIS** will publish the articles which are qualified on the *Journal of Data Science and Intelligent Systems* for **AAIEE 2025**.
- 2. **JDSIS** should not charge **AAIEE 2025** APC or any publishing fee if the paper is submitted before December 31st, 2025.
- 3. The editor of **JDSIS** will commit to publish the articles only after receiving and reviewing the articles of near-publishable quality.
- 4. The scopes of **JDSIS** is available on the <u>journal website</u>.
- 5. All submissions must adhere to **JDSIS**'s requirements (please refer to our <u>submission guidelines</u>) in Microsoft WORD format.
- 6. The external review process is coordinated by the **JDSIS**. The managing editor is responsible for preparing submissions for review, receiving and collating referee reports and forwarding the complete review material to the workshop organizer and editor. Each article is sent to editor for final decision with the peer-reviewed comments from **JDSIS**'s reviewer group. A minimum of two substantial reviews is required for the editorial decision.
- 7. All the contributing authors are expected to comply with the ethical and qualitative standards that **JDSIS** holds. This includes an obligation to respect the quality control that is supplied through the referee system. There is no possibility to guarantee contributors publication until adequate revisions in line with the referees' comments are completed and agreed to by the Editor. The Guest Editor(s) are expected to work collectively throughout the process in helping to contact the authors. In addition, the journal Editor will read through all submissions at these stages.
